## **PCSD ENROLLMENT CHECKLIST**

Age Requirements and Restrictions:
Pre-kindergarten, student must be four years of age prior to September 1 <sup>st</sup> .
Exception Student Education Pre-kindergarten, student birth to five years old
must meet requirements set forth by the State of Florida DOE.
Kindergarten, student must be five years of age prior to September 1 <sup>st</sup> .
First Grade, student must be six years of age prior to September 1 <sup>st</sup> and
completed an accepted kindergarten or been enrolled in a public school.
Complete PCSD Forms:
Pupil Information Sheet
Health Form/Chronic Disease Information
Home Language Survey
Proof of Residence
TWO current pieces of evidence from the following sources in the name of the parent/guardian
registering the child:
Current Florida Driver's License/Florida Identification Card.
Current utility bill in the name of the parent registering the child.
Mortgage commitment/contract or lease agreement with information of owner.
Financial Institution statement.
Evidence of Proper Age:
Official birth certificate.
If such certificate is not available, the following forms of notarized or duly attested evidence are
acceptable, but preferred in the following order:
A duly attested transcript of a certificate of baptism.
Insurance policy on the child's life, which has been in force at least two years.
A bonafide contemporary Bible record of the student's birth.
If none of the above are available, the following notarized evidence is acceptable:
An affidavit of age signed by the parent and accompanied by a certificate of age
signed by the public health officer.
Evidence of Medical Examination and Immunization
Students grades K-12, must present evidence of a medical examination performed
within twelve months prior to their initial enrollment.
Present a written objection pursuant to Florida State Statute 1003.22.
Florida Certificate of Immunization
If applicable, complete a thirty-day exemption form.
Evidence of Custody/Guardianship
Birth certificate or applicable court papers.
If the student is residing with someone other than the parent or legal guardian, the following provision
shall apply:
The individual registering the child must provide documentation of custody by an appropriate state agency.
If the student lives in a residence licensed by the Department of Children and
Families, the student may be enrolled in the school that serves that licensed
residence.
A bonafide In-Loco-Parentis relationship must be established.
